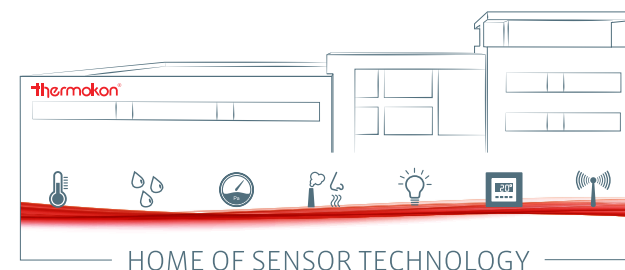

YOUR SAFETY AT THERMOKON





PARKING LOT:

- German traffic regulations apply at our compound.
- The speed limit is 10 km/h.
- Make sure that your car is not leaking any liquids (e.g. diesel or oils).
- Please park only in the designated visitor parking spaces. In case all parking spaces are occupied, please use the parking lot of the EDEKA supermarket.
- Entrances and access roads for emergency vehicles must be kept clear **at all times - please do not block them!**
- In the event of emergency please render first aid to the best of your ability until trained responders arrive, and make every reasonable effort to rescue persons in need. Please report accidents or damages to Thermokon personnel.
- Please be careful of fork lifts!



ASSEMBLY POINT:

In case of an alarm, please evacuate the building immediately via the marked emergency exits. Please report to the meeting point. At the assembly point, please wait for further instructions. The emergency exits as well as the meeting points are shown on the back of the site plan.



PRODUCTION AREA / WAREHOUSE:

When entering the production area and/or warehouse please take care of goods stacked on the floor – risk of stumbling!

Access to ESD protected areas is only permitted with appropriate footwear or ESD heel bands. Visitors are to be accompanied by Thermokon personnel in this area.

The taking of Thermokon material, including scrap, requires consent of personnel!



PHOTOGRAPHY / FILMING:

Taking pictures or filming is prohibited unless you have written approval from authorized personnel.



SMOKING:

Smoking is only allowed outdoors at the designated smoking area.



WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF FIRE

1. Report fire
*Actuate fire alarm and/or dial phone number: 112
Who is reporting? / What happened? / How many people are in the building? / Location of fire? / Standby to answer questions!*
2. Get out of danger / get into safety
Take endangered persons with you / Close doors / Follow the marked emergency exits / Report to the meeting point, do not use a lift / Wait for instructions
3. Attempt to extinguish the fire
Use fire extinguisher



WHAT TO DO IN CASE OF ACCIDENTS

1. Report accident
*Phone: 112
Where did the accident happen? / What happened?
How many injured persons? / What kind of injuries?
Standby to answer questions!*
2. First aid
Secure the scene of the accident / Take care of the injured persons / Follow instructions
3. Other measures
Direct ambulance or fire brigade / Disperse onlookers
